INTRODUCTION

Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya, a Government Degree College, is located in the midst of natural beauty on the Agartala-Simna Road in the Mohanpur Sub-division under the West Tripura district. The College is just 16 kms away from the Radhanagar Bus Stand, Agartala. The total area of the college campus is 24.4 acres. At present, there are 1926 students, 26 permanent Faculty Members and 30 Guest Lecturers in the college.

AFFILIATION & ACCREDITATION

The College, named after the great Indian philosopher and saint Swami Vivekananda, was inaugurated on 4th August 2012, and is permanently affiliated to Tripura University (A Central University) and has got recognition from the UGC under 12b & 2f {vide letter No.(8-174/2018(CPP-I/C) dated: 10/04/2018}. The College was accredited with B Grade by NAAC on 8th January 2020.

COURSES AT A GLANCE

The College began its academic works with the introduction of five general subjects - English, Bengali, Political Science, History and Education. Honours courses were introduced in History and Education during the academic year 2013-14. Science stream was introduced during the academic year 2014-2015. Honours courses in Political Science and Bengali were introduced in 2016, Honours courses in the Science stream in 2017, and English Honours was introduced in 2020. From the Academic session 2022-2023, five new subjects namely Geography, Economics, Physical Education, Philosophy and NCC have been introduced.

IMPLEMENTATION OF NEP 2020 FROM ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-2024

Keeping in line with the guidelines received from the Ministry of Education, Government of India, and the Department of Education (Higher), Government of Tripura, National Education Policy- 2020 is being implemented in our college from this academic session, i.e, 2023-2024. Guidelines of implementation shall follow the Regulations Governing Under Graduate Four Year Bachelor's Degree (1 year/ 2 year/ 3 year/ 4 year - Honours/Honours with Research) Program in Accordance with National Education Policy 2020' Ordinance published by the Tripura University dated 30.05.2023.

VISION

The College derives its strength from the teachings of Swami Vivekananda: "Learn everything that is good from others, but bring it in, and in your own way absorb it; do not become others."

The college thus strives to empower students by inculcating discipline, punctuality, empathy, physical strength, mental upliftment and development of character, and comradeship so that they possess a secular outlook, humanity and provide selfless service towards the society.

MISSION

- To provide quality education to students irrespective of caste, creed, religion and diverse socio-economic status.
- To create a holistic environment for students so as to transform them into responsible and sensible citizens.
- To develop commitment towards the conservation of Environment and make it sustainable.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

- a) To improve employability of the Graduates: The College provides proper counseling to the students and their guardians regarding the fact that Graduation in any discipline with excellent results and dynamism in terms of presentation has always a wider scope for employability in both public and private service sectors. To develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills among learners, NEP 2020 is being implemented from this academic session the goal of which is to make education more inclusive and accessible to all students.
- b) To improve the learning outcomes of the students: Unless learning outcomes of the students are improved, there is always a limited scope of better employability. In order to improve the learning outcomes and enhance their employability skills, Continuous Formative Assessment/Internal Assessments based on tests, assignments, seminar, case studies, project work etc., are conducted from time to time. In addition, students are introduced to the fundamentals of computer and e-learning. They are made familiar with smart classes and are compulsorily asked to participate in debates, seminars and workshops with oral and paper presentations.
- c) Enhancement of Research and Consultancy Activities: Many of the college faculties are engaged in research activities. They regularly

participate in Faculty Development Programs, Seminars and Workshops. They have published their research work in reputed national and international journals and also have many books to their credit. In addition, NEP 2020 implementation provides the opportunity to students to carry out research work in the 4th year of their respective UG Program.

ADMISSION IN 1ST SEMESTER (ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-2024)

Tripura University NEP-2020 Regulations provide detailed procedure for implementation of different provisions of NEP-2020 in Higher Education in terms of Under Graduate Degree (Honours/ Research) Programmes. The Regulations ought to preserve the academic autonomy of the Departments/ Colleges/ Institutes in formulating curriculum, outlining learning outcome descriptors, pedagogical approaches, evaluation methods and assignments of grades.

A. Eligibility for Admission

- Any student passing Higher Secondary/ H.S. (+2)/ Senior Secondary examination or its equivalent from any recognized Board/ Council shall be eligible for admission by the admission process conducted by Directorate of Higher Education, Govt. of Tripura to the 1st Semester of the Under Graduate (B.A./ B. Sc./ B. Com.) programme of studies subject to availability of seats. The students shall be taken into consideration for admission if he/she applied within five years from qualifying the previous examination. The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. Thus, a student who has passed 10+2 Examination not earlier than 2018 is eligible to apply for admission in the academic session 2023-2024.
- 2. For B.Sc. (Bio-Science) Programme: A candidate who has passed 10+2 stage with Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be eligible for admission.
- 3. For B. Com. Programme: A candidate who has qualified 10+2 with Commerce/Science shall be eligible for admission.
- 4. For B.A. Programme: A candidate who has qualified 10+2 in any stream shall be eligible for admission.

B. Selection Procedure

1. Intake capacity of various departments and the list of Major, Minor and Interdisciplinary subjects are given on Page Nos. 6-7 of this prospectus.

- 2. MAJOR, MINOR and INTERDISCIPLINARY Subjects should not be same.
- 3. A student can apply for maximum three subjects as MAJOR. MAJOR Subject shall be allotted strictly on the basis of merit.
- 4. Students may mention four (04) subjects for MINOR Course in order of preference (Mentioning four (04) subjects as MINOR in the application form is mandatory for students applying for B.A. Programme).
- 5. Students may mention four (04) subjects for INTERDISCIPLINARY Course in order of preference (Mentioning four (04) subjects as INTERDISCLIPLINARY in the application form is mandatory for students applying for B.A. Programme).
- 6. The Merit List shall be prepared on the basis of sum of marks of 'Best Five' subjects of H.S. +2 Examination and the subject opted as MAJOR.
 - a) If there is a tie in the sum, preference shall be given on the marks obtained in the subject opted as MAJOR (for breaking the tie).
 - b) If marks of the subject opted as MAJOR is also equal, then the date of birth of the candidate will be considered and the Senior Candidate shall be given preference.
- 7. A student who has failed in a subject in H.S. +2 shall NOT be allowed to take that subject as MAJOR.
- 8. The Merit List will be published for MAJOR Subject only.
- 9. Minor and interdisciplinary subject will be distributed among the students subject to availability of seat.
- 10. Reservation policy of Government of Tripura will be followed.

C. Admission Restriction

 If a candidate takes admission in any college, he/she cannot take admission in any other college. In case of admission in a second college, the admission in the first college must be surrendered.

(NOTE: 4th Year programme shall be provided to candidates subject to availability of adequate infrastructure in the college)

D. TRIPURA UNIVERSITY REGISTRATION

A student shall have to apply for University Registration in prescribed form through the Institution within 30 days from the last date of admission. No application for registration will be entertained after the expiry of this stipulated period.

The waiver of all kinds of fees as mentioned above except the fees of Affiliating Universities including Registration fee for the Girl students enrolled in such college/institution will continue to prevail as notified vide No.F.2(375)-DHE/UDCA/2005/2377(26) dated 22nd August 2022.

F. CHANGE OF SUBJECT/STREAM

A student shall be allowed to change a subject(s)/stream within 15 days from his/ her admission to the College. No such change shall be entertained once application for University registration is forwarded to the University from the college.

G. CHANGE OF COLLEGE

Candidate shall be permitted for change of college only for the odd semesters (in 3rd Semester) with the due consent from both the colleges (the Relieving College and the Admitting College) and with the permission from the Tripura University subject to availability of same combination of subjects studied in the previous College.

H. COURSE CURRICULUM & STRUCTURE OF COURSES (FIRST SEMESTER)

The curriculum has been divided into 2 semesters in each academic year and shall include lectures, tutorials, laboratory examination, seminars and projects apart from industrial training and educational tours etc. as decided in scheme and necessary instructions issued from time to time.

1. Students seeking admission in the first semester shall have to compulsorily take:

- 2. MAJOR, MINOR and INTERDISCIPLINARY Subjects should not be same.
- 3. Allotment to the MAJOR Course shall be strictly based on merit.
- 4. MINOR Course shall be distributed as per availability of seats.
- 5. INTERDISCIPLINARY Course shall be distributed as per availability of seats.
- 6. Allotment to Vocational Course (VC) and Value Added Course (VAC) shall be done as per availability of seats.
- 7. Total credits to be earned in second semester will be 20.
 - i) 1^{st} Semester (20 Cr.) + 2^{nd} Semester (20 Cr.) = 40 Cr.
 - ii) Students exiting the programme after getting 40 Cr. will be awarded the UG Certificate in the prescribed subject provided they secure 4 Cr. in skill based vocational courses offered during the 1st year and 2nd year summer term programme, i.e. exiting students need to undertake an internship of four credits additionally.
