AFSPA extended in Arunachal, Nagaland

Guwahati, Mar 28: In the wake of review in the internal security scenario in the Northeast region, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has extended the Armed Forces (Special Powers] Act (AFSPA) in certain districts of Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh for another six months with effect from April 1 next, A official, quoting the MHA notification, said that the AFSPA was extended in eight districts - Dimapur, Niuland, Chumoukedima, Mon, Kiphire, Noklak, Phek, and Peren - and 21 police station areas in five other districts of Nagaland, which has 16 districts. Most of these districts and police station areas are located close to the India-Myanmar border. Another MHA notification said that the AFSPA has been extended for an-

other six months in Tirap, Changlang, and Longding districts in Arunachal Pradesh as well as areas under the jurisdiction of Namsai, Mahadevpur, and Chowkham police stations in Namsai district, bordering Assam. The official said that the Centre took the step following a review of the law and order situation in Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh. The AFSPA empowers the Army, para-military, and other security forces to arrest a person without a warrant, enter or search premises without a warrant, along with some other actions. With the improvement in the security situation in the northeastern states, the Centre, in April 2022, reduced the number of disturbed areas under AFSPA in many areas of Nagaland, Assam and Manipur. It was lifted from Tripura in 2015, Meghalaya in 2018 and Mizoram in the 1980s.

TMC to fight at Karimgunj

Silchar, Mar 28: The Trinamool Congress is gearing up to field a candidate for the Karimganj Lok Sabha seat, a move that is expected to shake up the political landscape in the region. The candidate list has been submitted to the party high command, and an announcement is likely within three days. The elections in the Karimgani Lok Sabha constituency are scheduled for

According to sources, the names of former Congress leaders Parimal Roy, Salman Choudhury, and Badrul Islam Barbhuiya have been included in the list sent by the Karimganj District Trinamool Congress Committee to the State Committee. If Parimal Roy is nominated, it could pose a significant challenge for the BJP, as he has experience contestKarimganj assembly constituency and reportedly has strong connections with the local population. The Trinamool Congress, under the leadership of Sushmita Dev, has been actively campaigning in order to expand its presence in Assam, If Parimal Roy is nominated, he is expected to garner support from both the Hindu and Muslim communities, potentially splitting the vote and causing concern for the BJP.

DM visits Mulberry farm at Gakulpur

Agartala, Mar 28: Tarit Kanti Chakma ,District Magistrate & Collector of Gomati District is particularly fond of silk and today visited the biggest sericulture (mulberry) farm in the district spreading across 52 acres(130 Kani) in the Gakulpur area, under Udaipur subdivision to get to the bottom of the slow productivity and found it senile. Mulberry trees are struggling to survive due to wanting water. A good number of mulberry farmers are still involved in the silk cultivation industry despite generating a low income in comparison to other industries. The DM, Gemati District meticulously visualized the problems faced by the farmers in sustaining their livelihood and urged them not to desert this industry and assured them to take up the issue with the sericulture department to get redressed. Tripura has a reputation for producing good quality mulberry silk in the country. In terms of quality, it was said to be next only to

Bangalore. Many vendors used to come from outside the state to lift the mulberry silk of Tripura competing in a national bid tender at a very lucrative price as the silk industry by all terms did not flourish here. The local traders are not interested in merchandising this raw silk. The leaf of mulberry is solely used for feeding and rearing the silkworm The only diet silkworms are completely fed and sustain their life-cycle are mulberry leaves. Tripura's climatic condition and soil are conducive for cultivation of mulberry trees .The quality of mulberry leaves of this soil are at par in Karnataka and other parts of the country. Tripura is perhaps the only state in the country where the entire gamut of silk industry including mulberry plant cultivation and raw silk trading is totally managed by the government. The production of mulberry silk is shown to be increasing every year, although the real picture is a different story, according to many mulberry farmers, rearers, and stakeholders of the industry.

World Drama Day in Kailashahar held

Agartala, Mar 28: The World Theatre Day which is also known as World Drama Day was celebrated in the state on Wednesday. There were three theatre organizations in Kailashahar at Unakoti District which together celebrated the day.
